

**TOWN OF GLOVER, VERMONT  
PRIVATE ROADS AND DRIVEWAYS  
ORDINANCE**

**SECTION I. PURPOSE:**

This Ordinance is adopted under VSA Title 24, Chapter 59, Section 1971. The purpose of this Ordinance is to see that all Private Roads and Driveways being built off from Town Highways are properly built and meet the specifications of the Town of Glover Selectmen and Road Foreman.

**SECTION II. APPLICABILITY OF ORDINANCE:**

The terms of this Ordinance apply to all residents and non-residents, who for any reason may want to build a Private Road or Driveway off from any Town Highway in the Town of Glover.

**SECTION III. REQUIREMENTS OF ORDINANCE:**

1. Fill out an application for "Private Roads and Driveways Permit". Applications are available at the Glover Town Clerk's Office.
2. Contact the Road Foreman and set up an appointment to meet at the location where the Private Road or Driveway will be located.
3. When a culvert is needed for a Private Road or Driveway to an existing dwelling or a new construction for the purpose of residency, the Town of Glover will supply the culvert. All other materials and labor will be the obligation of the Landowner.
4. When a culvert is needed for a Private Road or Driveway for other purposes than principal dwelling, the landowner must purchase the culvert along with all other materials and labor.

**SECTION IV. ENFORCEMENT:**

The terms of this Ordinance shall be enforced by the Town of Glover. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, recording and publication as provided by law.
