Minutes of 1 August 2007

Approved without changes.

Roads

Nick's equipment is now repaired and he will resume roadside mowing immediately. We will ask Dean Gonyaw to mow around the pumping station on Rte. 16.

We will ask John Desjardin to sign off with us before mowing the field at Rte. 16 and Rte. 122.

Winter sand. Andy proposes that we crush stone at the same time we screen sand for this winter. This will save us extra handling and money over crushing at a later time. This will also provide us with three inch minus for mud holes in the spring. Because this would be an expense we did not budget for this year, Andy will check into the cost of buying what we need after the first of the year (on next year's budget) as compared to producing it from our own pit now.

Fuel Contracts

We agree that we will buy our heating fuel and diesel from Blanchard Oil, provided Fred's does not make a better offer. They are offering us considerable savings over Fred's current price.

Beach Hours and Fence

Neighbors close to the beach are asking that we close the beach at 8:00pm due to the noise. Nash will talk with Linda Gilman re this request and will report back at our next meeting.

Bill Ingalls at Round Hill Fence will install gate and fence for \$1195. We agree to accept his bid.

Town Hall Maintenance

The fire escape repair and rebuild is now complete. The other repairs are close to finished. We need to do some minor regrading on the south side to take water away from the building. This work will be put on next year's list if it cannot be done with our grader immediately.

The roof will need to be rescrewed and painted next year. Bill Pearce has submitted an estimate for this work.

Bill also recommends we replace the front steps with a steel frame and railing with replaceable wood treads (next year).

Park and Ride

Wayne Davis will visit on August 30th to take a look at this project.

Health Officer

A candidate for this position is being interviewed.

Town Vault Roof

The current roof was leaking badly. Nash and Keone removed the old roofing and replaced with ice and water shield last Friday. We will cover this with 90 lb double coverage roll roofing. This should hold it until we need to expand the vault.
