Sewer System Improvement

The select board chair has signed the bond vote warning.

Roads

Three days of culvert work has been completed. Menard Excavating was hired to do the ditching and excavator work.

Andy has met with FEMA and turned in the requested paperwork. They will respond with their figures for our comment. Payment to follow. There are eight specific sites for which we are asking assistance. Each qualifying site must require at least a thousand dollars of repair work. We have signed the memorandum of understanding allowing us to receive funds.

Speeding in the Village

Gary Sample is wondering what else we can do to slow down the traffic coming through the village on Rte. 16. We discussed the changes already in place and what else we might be able to do. Our hands are pretty thoroughly tied since the highway belongs to

the state. We do hope to be approved for a second crosswalk. Gary says the “traffic calming” radar did not seem to have any positive effect on traffic passing his place. We will try to get the speed limit lowered and continue to pursue other possibilities with the state. Nick will call the State Police to inform them that we are having increased problems with speeding in the village.

#### Pedestrian Crosswalk at Bean Hill Intersection

District nine of the Dept. of Transportation has acknowledged our request for a crosswalk and has forwarded it to their Traffic and Safety Division. Regarding the unmaintained and buried sidewalk along the west side of the road from Carleton Bickford’s lane down to the lower village, the Dept. of Transportation says its maintenance is our responsibility.

#### ATV use of Town Roads

Nick has put together a draft ordinance. Next step is to call a public information meeting to get a broader spectrum of reaction from town residents. Comments directly to Select Board members are welcome.

#### Library Proposal

The library trustees are requesting that the librarian be included as a town employee. This would be a part time position. The library will come to us with a 2008 budget and we will consider the request in our budgeting work for 2008.
