Transportation Advisory Committee

The Northeastern Vermont Development Association (Transportation Advisory Committee) is asking for our support in fighting the diversion of funds from the state transportation budget. We agree to send a letter of support.

Perron Parcels Cooperative Use Agreement

This agreement with Agency of Natural Resources Department of Fish and Wildlife is now in its second draft. The agreement involves approximately 6.5 acres located either side of the Barton River just south of the Still Hill bridge. This land is owned by DFW. The agreement calls for cooperation between the town and DFW in the maintenance and proper use of this stream-side land. We will sign as soon as the final copy is sent to us.

Glover Sewer System

The USDA grant which will pay for 45% of the West Glover sewer project will require the town to upgrade its handicap access to the municipal building. This work must be done by the time the sewer project is completed.

Hazardous Waste Cleanup

Environmental Products and Services will be arranging with our road crew to collect the contaminated stored at our gravel pit within the next week, weather permitting.
