Cold Spring Lane

Nickie Noel informed the board that the residence living on Cold Spring Lane would like a load of gravel to improve the road. The board sympathized with the residence but reiterated that the town is not responsible for maintenance of private roads. Nickie had done some research on the history of Cold Spring Rd and thought that the classification of the rd may be in error and that the town did indeed have responsibility to maintain at least a longer portion of the Rd. We informed Nickie that the town was in the process of researching and reclassifying all the roads in town due to the ancient roads issue that the state is presently facing. We recommended that Nickie contact Nick Ecker-Racz the town consultant on ancient roads, who would have the appropriate answer to her question. We also recommended that Nickie take a look at the town rd policy which clearly states the town's obligations concerning road maintenance.

Roads

Andy reports that the spring work was going well. RC Contractors had replaced a culvert on Beach Hill. Roland Bickford was hauling gravel for various road projects including County Rd and Dexter Mt. In the case of Dexter Mt. two culverts were replaced and associated ditching done. The excavation work was done by Tony Menard. The town discussed the pros and cons of hiring out excavation work and the appropriate billing procedure.

Unfortunately the heavy rains on Monday the 16th left behind considerable damage. Andy's initial estimate was around \$50,000. This damage amount is similar to last summers rain damage. Again we will be applying for a FEMA grant to help alleviate the cost of rebuilding. Last year we were fortunate enough to receive around \$70,000 in grant money for repair.

Sewer Project

The design and legal work for the town sewer project is nearing completion. The board met with Charlie Evens to discuss both the political and legal ramifications of the proposed sewer line which passes through Mr. Evans land on "The Old Town Road". During the research associated with the design of the sewer line it became apparent that the town did retain Right of Way to the "Old Town Road". In an effort to move the project forward and bring closure to the negotiations with Mr. Evans the town has tentatively agreed to relocate the proposed park and ride. The new location would be directly across the rd from the proposed site and the proposed site would be returned to a green space. Also the town would agree to provide the initial materials and labor to hook up a sewer unit at a location of Mr. Evans choosing. We are hoping to wrap up design and put together the RFP's by July 2, 2008. Work to begin on the project in August.

Miscellaneous

Other routine clerical and administrative matters were attended to.
