

GLOVER SELECTBOARD MEETING

MINUTES

Thursday, July 19, 2012

Present: Bucky Shelton, Jason Choquette, Jack Sumberg, Harvey Dunbar, Road Foreman and Cindy Epinette, Transcriber. Public: Gary Leach, Leach Engineering and Richard Epinette, Glover Recreation.

1. The meeting was called to order at 6:35pm.
2. Public Comment:
 - a. Sewer Update: Gary informed the board that John Harrys has approved all the projects discussed at the last meeting, they are covered by the grant. Brian Hanson, Barton Sewer, will have a proposal by the end of the month for updating the sewer charges. Jack spoke with Keone about a tentative agreement with Arnie Brown. Keone does not recall a special agreement.
 - b. GREC Update: Richard Epinette complimented the road crew on the work they did leading to the ball field. He informed the board that there is water at the ball field as well. He indicated that he has not been successful in finding a swimming instructor this year, no one has expressed an interest.
3. Road Update:
 - a. Sargent Lane: Harvey informed the board that FEMA came to inspect the bridge. They suggested working with an engineer to get an idea of what can be done. FEMA will reimburse Glover for the work that has been done to date.
 - b. Paving Roads: Pike would like to begin grinding County Road in August. The board suggested this project be delayed until September.
 - c. Harvey sought the board's advise on priorities. The board indicated that the work that involves FEMA is first priority then preparing the sand, for the winter needs.
 - d. Rodgers Road: The drawings are complete so it can go out to bid soon.
 - e. Bucket Rebuilt: Riverside Garage did a good job on rebuilding the bucket.
 - f. Borland Road Culvert: Mark Colburn told Harvey he would be willing to let Harvey install a culvert on his property on Borland Road. The board authorized Harvey to install the culvert.
 - g. Mowing: Mowing will begin Monday, July 23, 2012.
4. Board Discussion:
 - a. The board reviewed the monthly report by the Orleans County Sheriff's Department.
 - b. Trees interfering on sidewalk: The board received a letter requesting the trees that hang over the sidewalk be trimmed. Jack will speak with Charlie Barrows.
 - c. Mold at the Municipal Offices: Donna requested the board investigate the smell of mold at the Municipal Office Building. The board suggested getting a dehumidifier to dry out the basement.
