

TOWN OF GLOVER, VERMONT
SELECT BOARD MEETING
GLOVER MUNICIPAL BUILDING
JULY, 1, 2010

Officers Present: Jason Choquette-Select Board Chair, Bucky Shelton-Selectman, Donna Sweeney-Town Clerk (Taking minutes for Tara Nelson-Board Clerk who was ill) Harvey Dunbar-Road Foreman

Guest Present: Nicholas Ecker-Racz

Jason called the meeting to order at 6:25 p.m.

Nick spoke about putting a load of gravel on the state land at the foot of Still Hill To make a couple of parking spots. He also said he would mow to big rock again Bucky suggested he look over the agreement as it has been awhile. Nick said he knows what the agreement says as he worked a long time getting the agreement in place and told the story. He would like to see some money put in the budget for a couple benches to put there. He said you can get rod iron benches for \$50.00 each.

Nick said there is a sidewalk from Deer Lane down to the Pudvah house; he has seen it on maps. He thinks it should be opened up. Harvey said last year he tried to poke the area when they we putting up stakes. He found nothing but is not saying that it is not there.

Nick also spoke with VLCT about insurance for swimming lessons and GREG taking over swimming lessons. Donna said that Tara and herself spoke with Fred from VLCT and he strongly suggests that the Town not take them over.

Nick said he heard that the town chose not to pay a health officer. Donna said that the town has never paid a health officer that it is an appointed state position. Nick has been on the Select Board and Health Officer and should have known that. Nick said if Sue Gibeault resigns he will take the job, but he would like some compensation for his work.

Harvey will contact Russell Guyer and see when he is going to start the road sides. Jason will go around with him to see which roads need the mowing. Bucky reminded Harvey that on Still Hill there is a tree up by Marguerite Histed's that needs to be taken care of and between Butch Carrier's sugar house and Gerard Carrier's there is not room for two cars to meet. The brush has taken over the road.

Harvey spoke with the state Transportation and they will pay for and fix the end of Bailey Lane and it was approved. He also found out there are 4 manholes between Glover and Barton that belong to the town, which makes it eight manholes we need to raise before the state paves next year. Jason and Bucky thought they were off the road and will check them out.

Harvey said he received a packet from the state and we need to replace all road signs (as the state has been doing) within the next five years. He will have Juanita take a ride around one day soon and take inventory of all signs and then he can figure out what it will cost.

Juanita has been working with a student from Lyndon State College to update the culvert inventory. They found one on Perron Hill that is listed as critical, Harvey will look at it. This project is through NVDA and does not cost the town.

Donna will speak to Harvey (as he had left) and ask him to put some top soil around the new well area and grass seed it. Don Atkins is going to paint the cement post. Donna reported that the water test came back ok for the well.

Donna will contact the Orleans County Sheriff's Department and see what the price would be to contract with them for a minimal amount of hours a week.

Bucky will speak with Parker Pie Company and schedule a special Select Board meeting with them and anyone else who wishes to attend, to discuss the parking problems and other concerns people may have.

The agreement with Sullivan, Powers & Company was signed. This is the company doing the Federal Audit.

Select Board signed the Certificate of Compliance to State's Attorney for unlicensed dogs.

Select Board approved the final bill from Tri-State Drilling & Boring, Inc.

Select Board signed permission for Vermont Electric Cooperative, Inc to put power overhead in the town right-a way on Dexter Mountain for Alfred Carrier.

Donna will notify the Select Board when the tax rate is ready for their approval and they will come in and review, approve, sign if they all agree.

Orders were signed
