

**TOWN OF GLOVER, VERMONT  
SELECT BOARD MEETING  
GLOVER MUNICIPAL BUILDING  
JUNE 17, 2010**

Officers Present: Jason Choquette-Select Board Chair, Tara Nelson-Selectperson/Board Clerk, Bucky Shelton-Selectman

Guests Present: Ellen Bowen

1. Jason called the meeting to order at 6:34 p.m.
2. Ellen Bowen from Orleans County Citizens Advocacy (OCCA) discussed her organization's function and goals. OCCA is a non-profit organization that builds and supports one-to-one relationships between community volunteers and people with development disabilities. OCCA relies on donations, fundraisers and town appropriations. Their goal is make 6-8 matches per year. OCCA is currently the only program of its sort left in Vermont. Ellen is going from town to town to make sure select boards know what the organization does.
3. The select board reviewed the agreement between the State of Vermont and the Town of Glover regarding the Fish and Wildlife land near the town green. Bucky will follow up with Nick Ecker-Racz about this, as Nick would like to do some mowing there.
4. The select board reviewed a letter from the State of Vermont stating they want to remove the island at the bottom of Bailey Lane to create a "T" intersection. The board will have Harvey Dunbar look into this.
5. The select board approved the audit proposal from Sullivan, Powers and Company.
6. RC Contractors will start the bridge at the bottom of Bean Hill Road next week. The state has approved the project, except no work on the wing walls can be done in the water until approval is received. RC Contractors would like to work Saturdays. The select board approved this, as long as the road isn't closed.
7. Vermont League of Cities and Towns (the town insurance carrier) has reached an agreement with Fairpoint for the pole and wires that were knocked down accidentally last August. VLCT will pay \$1,585.96 to Fairpoint. VLCT was successful in getting Fairpoint to remove administrative fees. The select board approved the \$1,585.96 settlement with Fairpoint.
8. Bruce Baraw has requested sewer charges be removed for one of his two units. He is no longer renting the upstairs apartment and does not plan on renting it out in the future. The select board approved this under the condition he notify the town office if he decides to rent it out in the future.

9. The select board discussed the parking issues at Parker Pie in West Glover. Bucky and Jason are working on this.
10. Orders were signed.
11. Minutes were approved.
12. Jason made a motion to adjourn at 7:52 p.m.
