

**TOWN OF GLOVER, VERMONT
SELECT BOARD MEETING
GLOVER MUNICIPAL BUILDING
MARCH 18, 2010**

Officers Present: Jason Choquette-Select Board Chair, Tara Nelson-Selectperson/Board Clerk, Bucky Shelton-Selectman, Harvey Dunbar-Road Foreman

Guests Present: Gary Leach, Nick Ecker-Racz

1. Jason called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
2. Gary Leach presented the select board with the well replacement plan for the municipal building. Gary will review the plan with the state district engineer. Bucky has been in contact with Gosselin's Water Wells.
3. Tara signed an invoice for Leach Engineering in the amount of \$2,520. This is for work on the Route 16 pump station and proposed generator for that site. This is reimbursable under the USDA grant.
4. Nick suggested the select board look at grinding Perron Hill Road, as the pavement is in poor condition. It could then be packed with chloride. The select board has been discussing Perron Hill Road and what options are available. State paving aid is not available for it because it is a Class III road.
5. Jason and Harvey are going to look at the upper part of County Road. There are culverts that need cleaning out, and water is running down the road.
6. Nick suggested putting a section in the road policy about loggers modifying town roads. Based on his past experiences, he feels this may be necessary.
7. Nick said he can put a bid in for mowing. His rate would be \$65 per hour.
8. Jason signed the Better Back Roads grant for \$10,000.
9. The select board signed the purchase agreement with Milton-Cat for the excavator. The total is \$103,500. Harvey checked into interest rates, and the Community National Bank is offering a much lower rate than financing with Milton-Cat. The town will finance with Community National Bank for 2.7% for five years.
10. The clutch was replaced in truck #2 (old truck), as well as other maintenance work. The total invoice was \$2,500.
11. The State of Vermont has approved the Bridge #6 project, but the money has yet to be approved as the legislature is still working on the budget.

12. The select board appointed Donna Laurin as the Town Service Officer. The select board signed the appropriate paperwork to be sent to the state.
13. Town officers were appointed. The only change is the appointment of Bucky Shelton as the Inspector of Wood, Lumber and Shingles.
14. The petroleum clean-up monitoring at the ambulance bay will continue twice per year.
15. The select board discussed the possible sale of the old West Glover wastewater site. The select board will ask Donna what the acreage of the site is and what it was sold for back in the 1980s. The select board may then ask the listers for advice in determining a value.
16. The select board reviewed a letter and information book from Green Mountain Power regarding the Lowell Mountain Wind Project.
17. Orders were signed.
18. Minutes were approved.
19. Jason made a motion to adjourn at 8:30 p.m.
