

**TOWN OF GLOVER, VERMONT
SELECT BOARD MEETING
GLOVER MUNICIPAL BUILDING
OCTOBER 1, 2009**

Officers Present: Jason Choquette-Select Board Chair, Tara Nelson-Selectperson/Board Clerk, Bucky Shelton-Selectman, Andy Brosseau (for Harvey Dunbar-Road Foreman)

Guests Present: Mike Ladd, Gracie Caslani

1. Jason called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.
2. Gracie Caslani asked the board to reconsider installing a culvert at her driveway. The board previously stated that a culvert wouldn't help her situation as there is no ditch where she wants the culvert. Gracie said Rick Welch, former road foreman, promised her one. The new gravel she has bought is washing out and she would like something done. Andy said he doesn't feel that a culvert would help drain her driveway; however the ditch across the road probably needs cleaning out. Crowning the road more may also help her situation. The board asked Andy to have Harvey look into this as soon as he can. Gracie told Andy the road crew did a wonderful job on Dexter Mountain Road this summer.
3. The Solid Waste Implementation Plan was discussed. The town needs to have two public hearings on this plan before it can be adopted. This plan was originally submitted several years ago by the previous select board. There were several revisions made. The current select board made two sets of revisions recently and the plan is considered "pre-approved" until the board adopts it after the two public hearings. Mike Ladd took a copy of the plan. Mike also said Dexter Mountain Road came out good.
4. Andy discussed the road issues, as Harvey could not attend.
 - A. The board approved Andy's request to have Roland Bickford fix a culvert on King Road. The culvert has separated where the band is. Roland is in that area with his excavator working on another project.
 - B. The beavers have dammed the ditch near Daniels Pond Road. Andy asked if the road crew could have John Rodgers clean it out with his excavator. The board approved this.
 - C. Robert Blow wrote a letter to the board asking for work to be done on Cold Spring Lane. Jason questioned where the town road ends and the private road begins. Andy thinks the town owns 700 feet before it is a private road. Andy (and Harvey) will look into this and see what needs to be done on the road.

- D. Jason said he still needs to talk to the snowmobile club about moving the trail that is near the gravel pit. Andy has talked to Merle Young about ideas for it.
 - E. Jason called Dale Perron from the state and asked what the town needs to do to have a crosswalk put on Route 16 near the Riverside Apartments. A similar request was denied in the past. Dale told Jason to submit a letter explaining why the board feels there should be a crosswalk there. The Riverside Apartments and Tammy Perron's daycare were not there when the original request was denied.
 - F. A West Glover resident suggested to Tara that a snow fence be put up around the new sewer control panel near the ambulance bay. Bucky said this was discussed during the substantial completion inspection.
 - G. School plowing was discussed. Tara said she called the Central Office and asked about other school budgets in the district. Glover is the only elementary school in this district that doesn't have a budget line item for snow removal. The town is still willing to plow, but feels the school may want to show this cost in their budget as it is a school expense. The next school board meeting is Tuesday, October 13, 2009 at 6:00 at Glover School. The select board will try to attend this meeting. Andy will let Harvey know about this meeting.
 - H. Bucky has received calls about Mud Island Road. There is an old private spring very close to the road that is of concern. Andy said the ditch is clean there. He will have Harvey look at it.
5. Jason signed the State of Vermont request for reimbursement for the signs that were purchased for the paving project on County Road.
 6. The select board read an invitation from the Union House for an Autumn Celebration on October 13, 2009 from 3:00-6:00.
 7. Orders were signed.
 8. Minutes were approved.
 9. Jason made a motion to adjourn at 8:12 p.m.
