

**TOWN OF GLOVER, VERMONT
SELECT BOARD MEETING
GLOVER MUNICIPAL BUILDING
SEPTEMBER 2, 2010**

1. Jason called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m.
2. The select board discussed the issue of water infiltrating in to the sewer system in Glover Village. Gary Leach and Bucky are going to check into this further. Bucky has the map from Gary showing where the water is coming from.
3. The select board discussed the problems with the Route 16 sewer pump. Rubber gloves and other items keep shorting out the pumps. Tara spoke with Pat Russell from the Union House and Pat said she would talk to her staff again about not flushing certain items. Nick said there was a letter sent to the Union House when he was on the select board stating the problems and what they would need to do. The select board will see if Donna can find a copy of this letter.
4. Nick said he thinks Mike Stanley is interested in purchasing the Ira Hunt property on Duck Pond Road (the town of Glover currently owns this). For many years this property didn't show up on any town lists. Since 1976 it has been a tax-exempt property for Glover. There is no deed, as the property is believed to have gone unclaimed for a number of years. The board would consider selling this if Mike Stanley is interested.
5. The select board is still looking at a value for the old West Glover leach field. Bucky said Dean Gonyaw is interested in the town land along Route 16.
6. Nick suggested cutting the dead trees along the roads, as they can be a hazard. He also suggested notifying the power company of any trees that need cutting near the power lines.
7. Jason spoke to Dale Perron regarding trees that have branches that are hanging in the town right of way (the tree bases are not growing in the right of way). He said the town can cut the branches that are in the right of way. Bucky spoke to Deb Markowitz, Secretary of State, and she gave the same answer as Dale. She also suggested talking to the land owners first, which the select board agreed is a good idea.
8. Jason signed the reimbursement request for the USDA grant for the sewer project.

9. The select board signed permission for Fairpoint to maintain poles on Mud Island Road.
10. The select board reviewed a meeting notice for Nathaniel Gordon to install a wind turbine at his house on Beach Hill Road.
11. The select board reviewed information from Big Green Recycling.
12. The select board reviewed information from the Agency of Natural Resources regarding the Lowell wind project.
13. The select board read a notice regarding flu shots. They are free for VLCT Health Trust subscribers and dependents.
14. Orders were signed.
15. Minutes were approved.
16. Jason made a motion to adjourn at 8:30 p.m.
