

**TOWN OF GLOVER, VERMONT  
SELECT BOARD MEETING  
CLASSIFICATION OF ROADS  
GLOVER MUNICIPAL BUILDING**

**August 14, 2011**

1. **Meeting called to order:** Bucky Shelton called the meeting to order at 7:06am.

**Town Highway 14-Young Road** (skipped over and needed to come back to this roadway on Monday August 22, 2011).

**Town Highway 18 - Still Hill Road-** is currently classified as a class three road for 1.57 miles. The .57 mile beyond the Shelton residence is presently classified as a class three road. **Action taken-** The .57 tenths of a mile will be re-classified as class 4. The board will send letter to adjacent land owners.

**Town Highway 17 - Cemetery Loop Road- Action taken-** To clarify the sections of Cemetery Loop, Town Highway 17 will be re-measured and the town will report to the state their findings. No letters need to be sent to bordering residents about this highway.

1985- Town Highway 17 in Town Highway Book II, pg. 44, Action was taken on April 10, 1985 to classify the road as a class 3. On March 8, 1985 the road was re-classified from a class 4 to a class 3 road.

**Town Highway 56- Steven Brown Road- Action taken-**The road will be classified as a 3<sup>rd</sup> class road up to the turnaround point for town trucks.

Measurements will be taken by the road crew before reporting their findings to the state.

**Town Highway 53-** .06 tenths of a mile of the road is currently classified as a class 3 road **Action taken-** that .06 tenth of a mile will be changed to a class 4 road. Boarding neighbors to be notified will be Manville Powers, Nickolas Ecker-Racz and Harvey Dunbar.

**Robert Theatralt-Land deed back.** Mr. Theatralt would like the town to deed back a strip of land, about 300 feet of lake shore, from the point of Tom Snider residence to Lake Parker Road. This will be warned for a public hearing; either it will be discussed at the next town meeting or a separate public hearing. This could be included in the land research, Tara Nelson said. Mr. Theatralt is agreeable of the trail/ foot path which is currently there and will continue to let this recreation be used and accessed as it is.

In Land Records, 25, pg. 496, September 25, 1963 the land was deeded to the town by the Theatralt family.

**Town highway 54- Hinman Settler Road- Action taken-** re-measure town highway 54 to discontinue the extension of highway 54.

**Sand Hill-Highway 42-**Measurement will be taken from route 16, to where the town trucks turn around.

**Town highway 61-North Greensboro Road-** On February 10, 1976, Town highway, vol. II, pg. 14 classified as a class 4 highway. Need to report to the state that this highway is class 4.
