AMENDMENT TO
ORDINANCE NUMBER ONE

SPECIAL REGULATIONS OF THE SELECTMEN PUSUANT TO TITLE 24
V.S.A., SECTION 1971, 2291 AND TITLE 23 V.S.A., SECTION 1007 AND 1008, THE
FOLLOWING REGULATIONS WERE ADOPTED BY THE SELECTMEN OF THE
TOWN OF GLOVER, VERMONT ON JUNE 1, 2000.

BASED UPON AN ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC STUDY, THE SELECTMEN
HAVE DETERMINED THAT THE SPEED OF 25 MPH, IS A SAFE AND PRUDENT
SPEED, WITHIN CERTAIN GEOGRAPHICAL AREAS OF THE TOWN OF
GLOVER, COUNTY OF ORLEANS AND STATE OF VERMONT. THE MAXIMUM
SPEED LIMIT OF ALL MOTOR VEHICLES SHALL NOT EXCEED 25 MPH.

ORDINANCE NUMBER ONE

A-1 A PERSON SHALL NOT OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE ON THE
FOLLOWING TOWN HIGHWAY IN EXCESS OF 25 MPH.

1. TOWN HIGHWAY NUMBER 57, ALSO NAMED SQUARE ROAD, FROM
THE INTERSECTION OF STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 16 TO THE GLOVER
SHEFFIELD TOWN LINE.
