

Glover Planning Commission
March 30, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 4:07 PM.

Randy, Mariel, Jim, Ann C., Ann L., Jack and Liz were present.

Ann L. moved to approve the minutes from March 16th, Ann C. seconded. So approved.

Nine people came to the energy movie "Growth Busters". A good discussion followed, for instance: "What happens to the materials in solar panels after their use is over?". The VT Digger Cindy Hill letter was referenced.

Randy, Mariel and Jack have reviewed all the strategies, goals and objectives and tried to make the structure and working consistent.

Jim has the list of required maps to be included in the flood resilience program.

We will put the link for Current Use in the body of the plan and not put in the appendix.

We discussed small corrections, Clarifications and technical issues.

We are waiting on the State and NVDA for energy and housing details and some input on Education from Brian to finish up the plan.

The "Town Plan" will define Glover's position on Act 250 permits.

Jim mentioned that Jens Heilke @ VT.Gov works for ANR would do a presentation about connected woodlands. He is now involved with BioFINDER, from a state wide scale to small vernal pools.

Randy would like to add "Melissadata.com to our resource page.

We did more text editing:

Town beautification issues such a junk in private yards is hard to enforce, but can be discussed by the selectmen and the people involved. Warnings and fines can be levied but there is really not much power.

We discussed the possibility of making a small park on the corner of the Glover green on the strip of land behind the utility building, bordered by the river. We looked at town maps and still aren't sure if the town or the fire department "owns" that land. To be continued...

The Energy section is being kept very general until we get the specifics from the regional platform, the PSB and NVDA.

We determined we don't need appendix C because we can insert links to all the conservation programs right on page 4.

The LocalMotion meeting is to be scheduled in the spring.

The facilities map is done, wetlands map is done, and the transportation map is done. We still need real estate map and a lake map.

Ann C. told us that VT Efficiency is sending Jen Severitt at 6:30 to talk at the Town Hall.

The next meeting is April 13 at 4 PM in the Library.
