

Glover Planning Commission minutes
November 3, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 4:05 PM.

Randy, Mariel, Jim, Jack, Ann C. and Liz were present.

Randy has not heard back from Martha Braithwaite.

The minutes from Oct. 20th were approved as written, except for the wrong meeting date:

Thursday, Nov. 4th should have been Thursday, Nov. 3rd. (My apologies)

We reviewed the updated compilation by Mariel of the Town Plan and made some adjustments for typos, fact corrections and grammar, and a few additions and subtractions.

Ann C. asked if the cell phone towers should be mentioned in the plan as it is a problem for rural access.

We will all review the Education section.

Ann C. explained the Energy Planning Standards from Hope; that they have to be in sync with the Regional Municipal Plan. Randy recommended that the NVDA finish the Regional Plan and then we can take what we need from it.

Ann C. observed that we are required to assess Glover's energy needs and capacity. We feel this is beyond the ability of the Glover Planning Commission. There may be a training session in December.

The NVDA site has a regional housing plan; perhaps we can read it and adapt it for Glover.

We will put Glover's population statistics as a table in the body of the plan.

We will invite GREC representatives to the next meeting to discuss their plans.

The Economic Opportunities section is all reviewed.

Energy, Housing and Education remain to be completed and edited.

Mariel remarked that we should continue at this accelerated pace to wrap up what we can of the Town Plan. Therefore we decided that next meeting will be in two weeks at the Glover Library on **Thursday, Nov. 17th** but it will be at **3 pm to 5 pm** as several members want to participate in a "Roll-in" (pies for food banks) at Sterling College starting at 6 pm.

Ann C. Moved to adjourn and Mariel seconded the motion.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:30 PM.
