

Glover Planning Committee meeting

September 4, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 7:15 PM at the Glover Library.

Ann Creaven, Jack Sumberg, Liz Nelson, Skip Borrell and Ann Lidner were present.

We reviewed the plan; the fire department reported to Ann but the Power Company did not send a plan about limb cutting.

We will include a statement saying that we used the Tunbridge Plan as a model, as suggested by NVDA.

We reviewed the two proposals for the flood mitigation and resilience plan from the \$3000 grant coordinated with Barton's flood plan. The two proposals were from Bear Creek, Montpelier and Northwoods Stewardship Center, East Charleston. Both proposals were very similar in their approach, and the same in cost. We unanimously voted to recommend the Northwoods Stewardship Center's plan, as they are a more local business. Liz so moved and Skip seconded.

The Select Board is likely to take our recommendation.

We discussed the dam at the end of Shadow Lake. Jack is the "keeper of the key" for the dam and water level. We need to train a monitor or two for Shadow Lake as it is on the significant hazard list. Some houses would be affected if the dam broke. We discussed emergency action plans for the Shadow Lake dam.

Jack will put the whole hazard mitigation plan together, review it with Glover Planning Committee, submit it and post it on the Glover website and post the meeting for public review by the end of September.

The next Glover Planning Committee meeting is October 16, 2014.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:10.
