


TOWN OF GLOVER
Special Selectboard Meeting Minutes
Monday, January 19, 2026 – Glover Public Library


Present: Anne Eldridge, Adam Heuslein, Mike Pray, Road Foreman Steve Maleski, and Cindy Epinette, Town Treasurer.
Attending via Zoom: Justin Mason.

1. The meeting was called to order at 12:08pm.
2. **Additions or deletions to the agenda:** A discussion regarding the agenda for 1/22/26, Martin Luther King Holiday, Letter of support for wake boats were added to the agenda.
 - a. **January 22, 2026 agenda:** The Board agreed to postpone having a meeting with Barton Village regarding the wastewater system until January 29th if that is agreeable with Barton Village. The Board will also add a discussion regarding the personnel policy.
 - b. **Martin Luther King Holiday:** Justin made a motion, seconded by Anne, to include Martin Luther King Day as a paid holiday, effective January 19, 2026. The motion carried.
 - c. **Recycling:** Jim and Theresa are working at the Recycling Center this morning.
 - d. **Letter of Support Regarding WakeBoat activities in Glover:** Brenda Plastridge requested an updated letter of support from the Selectboard, banning wakeboat activity on all the lakes in Glover. **Adam made a motion, seconded by Justin, to authorize Anne to sign the letter on behalf of the Board. The motion carried.**
3. **Public Comment: none**
4. **Proposed 2026 Budget Discussion:** The Board discussed the proposed 2026 budget. Adam has done some research with Caledonia Sheriff's Office for law enforcement in Glover. He has not received any specifics, but Caledonia Sheriff's office is willing to discuss this possibility further. Adam proposed increasing the Public Safety budget to \$20,000. To offset the increase, he suggested reducing the Gravel-Crushing budget line to \$70,000. They debated reducing the Equipment Reserve Fund allocation of \$150,000 but decided against it. **Adam made a motion, seconded by Justin, to adopt the proposed 2026 budget of \$1,539,224.99. The motion carried.**
5. **Sign the 2026 Town Meeting Warning:** This is postponed until Thursday, January 22nd.
6. **Adjourn:** Adam made a motion, seconded by Anne to adjourn the meeting at 2:02pm.
