

**TOWN OF GLOVER**  
**Cemetery Commissioners Emergency Meeting Minutes**  
**Tuesday, November 19, 2024 – Glover Town Clerk’s Office**

Present: Joan Alexander, Nick Ecker-Racz, Theresa Perron, and Cindy Epinette, Cemetery Sexton. Absent: Deb Wesoja and Amy Wright.

1. The meeting was called to order at 5pm.
2. The Commissioners received a special request to allow a full burial after November 1<sup>st</sup>. **Nick made a motion, seconded by Joan, to approve making an exception to the Rules & Regulations to allow a burial after November 1<sup>st</sup>. The motion carried.** The decision was based on the following circumstances and conditions: There is no snow on the ground therefore locating the exact location of the site will not pose a problem. The ground is not frozen therefore digging at the site will not jeopardize the stones and markers on adjoining graves. The ground will be opened and a piece of plywood will be placed over the site to prevent anyone or anything from falling into the grave. Joan has tried to reach Jon Perkins to get his input. Jon has not responded to Joan’s phone calls. The grave site is close to the access road, therefore when the time comes for the burial to occur the only problem will be plowing. The family will be responsible for clearing the snow on the road to gain access to the burial site. However, a traditional plow cannot be used due to the fact that plowing could harm or displace stones along the edge of the access roads. Theresa will speak with the family about this decision. Deb and Amy could not attend the meeting but had emailed their support to approve this request.
3. **Policy Review:** Nick has suggested several changes to the existing Cemetery Rules & Regulations. Cindy will incorporate those changes into the existing Rules & Regulations and send the proposed changes to everyone for review and consideration. They will be discussed at the next meeting. Joan, Theresa and Nick suggested changing the rules to include language that, depending upon weather conditions, exceptions could be made to have burials after November 1<sup>st</sup> and before May 1<sup>st</sup>. Deb and Amy could not attend, but they emailed their opinion that the policy should change as well. The next meeting is scheduled for December 4, 2024 at 5pm at the Glover Public Library.
4. **Adjourn: The meeting was adjourned at 6pm.**
