E Bikes- Starting up mid April, David has been in contact with Toni @ the library and that will work out well. He and Mariel will bring them downstairs and make sure they are ready. We are not going to rent them out the week of 7/24 so they can be available for Glover Day.

Thermal Camera update- David has been reviewing different options in our price range \$300 to \$500 and has found one that seems good. He will email the info to the committee and then we can make the decision. Will need to talk about the process itself. Infrared thermometers are not very expensive, around \$30, don't give as much useful information. Not sure if we need to get the thermometer or just stick with the camera. We'll talk more about it more but as of right now doesn't seem to be a need to pursue it.

Glover Day- We'll have a table with pamphlets etc. We'll have the e-bikes and we are also going to do a drawing for 5 free window inserts, any NEK resident is eligible, and can be transferred to another NEK resident. For anyone we'll do a separate drawing for an energy basket that will have different things- starting with but not limited to light bulbs, thermometer, insulation things, low flow showerhead.

VEEP Programs- Mariel and Ann have been looking into getting them to go into Glover School to do a workshop. They will schedule a time to meet with the Principal to try and find something that will work.
