

## Glover Energy Committee Minutes, June 16, 2025

HYBRID MEETINGS: While we now have a regular link to our meetings, those of us present did not know how to “host,” so were unable to open to others. Ann will be in touch with Angela to learn what is needed to do this.

WINDOW DRESSERS: Ann, David, and Mariel all attended an online WDMeasurers Training. Mariel did a measuring with Craig Taylor, and Mariel and Ann did another measuring just last week. Mariel will continue to contact folks on our Glover list who have made orders - to arrange times to have measuring done. Ann and Dave will help with measuring.

Ann reports she called Efficiency Vermont for clarification about their rebate for inserts. She was told a Vermont customer can now get a \$100 rebate for just one window - even if the window costs less than that. It used to apply only for a minimum of 3 windows. She noted that Window Dressers has not updated this change on their website. We agree to be in touch with new co-ordinator, Donald DeVoil about this.

We discuss getting volunteers to help at the Community Build in Craftsbury. Ann will see if Angela can access the list of volunteers from previous Glover Builds, to see if we can persuade some of them to volunteer again for the upcoming Build in early November.

E-BIKES: Folks have started signing up at the Glover Library to borrow our E-Bikes. We need to keep getting the word out about their availability. David will continue to check them weekly for maintenance.

LASER THERMOMETERS AND CAMERA: We need to figure out how to get these into circulation. Ongoing topic for discussion.

GLOVER DAY: We decide not to table at Glover Day since we don't need any more insert customers this year - due to not having a local coordinator

to oversee a Glover Build. The Craftsbury Local Coordinator, Kevin Gregoire, has graciously agreed to let us join their Build to accommodate those from our area who have already ordered inserts. So as not to overwhelm the Craftsbury Build - we agreed to limit our insert numbers to around 50 this year, so we will not be soliciting more orders.

MERP \$4000 MINI GRANT: We agree to prioritise remaining funds for getting VEEP into our local schools next school year. Any left over funds will be applied to “soft” costs of implementation of our MERP LEVEL II GRANT PROJECT.

ENERGY COMMITTEE EXPANSION: We talk about how we can get more folks to join our Committee. Another ongoing topic for discussion.

NEXT MEETING: July 7th, 4 pm, at Glover Library. Hybrid will hopefully be available as well.
