Meeting Minutes

Glover Public Library


Present: Joan Alexander, Theresa Perron, Nick Ecker-Racz, Amy Wright, and Cindy Epinette, Sexton.

Absent: Deb Wesoja

1. Nick Ecker-Racz called the meeting to order at 5:12pm.
2. Minutes: **Theresa made a motion, seconded by Amy, to approve the minutes dated May 28, 2025. The motion carried.**
3. Financial Update: Cindy distributed the trial balance to date. It was noted we have received \$3,442 in donations as a result of the appeal letter. No other major changes have occurred. **Nick made a motion, seconded by Joan, to keep \$10,000 in the checking account and move the rest into the CD so it can earn more interest. The motion carried.**
4. Review Rules & Regulations: Section X (a-g) was reviewed. Cindy will update the Rules & Regs and forward the results to everyone.
5. Feasibility of Winter Green Burials: Joan will invite Bob Richards to the next meeting to discuss ways to have green burials in the winter.
6. Kiosks Report: Bob Richards and Waylon Young placed the kiosks in each cemetery. Joan will update the information that will be placed in the kiosks, and laminate them as needed. It was suggested that a map be included and possibly a URL code, if cell service is available. Joan will come up with some designs that can be drawn on the kiosks to make them more decorative.
7. Update on Signs: Joan will seek organizations that can create a sign for the cemeteries. Theresa will contact Dennis Gibson to inform him we will research other contractors.
8. Update on Fencing: The folks from the correctional center will be on site July 7th – 9th to build the fence in Westlook I. Joan is waiting for the contract from Paul Trucott. Nick will review the number of posts needed.
9. Update on Professional Stone Work: Joan reviewed the stones that need to be repaired/replaced with Scott from Heritage Memorial. There are a lot of stones that need to be fixed. Scott suggested an amount of money be set and he will fix the stones up to that figure. Heritage is very conscientious about the work they do. **Joan made a motion, seconded by Nick, to pay Heritage \$7,000 to repair/replace stones this year. The motion carried.**
10. Update on Summer Youth Help/Volunteers: Fiona Bock is willing to work this summer, Damien Conley is willing to work when he is available and Waylon is willing to paint the fences.
11. Plans for Memorial Garden landscaping: We need to weed the memorial garden. It was decided to plant a tree this year. Cindy/Nick/Joan will research the type of tree appropriate for the garden.
12. Plans for Natural/Green Burial landscaping: Nick will plant more natural flowers.

13. Update to Increasing Land at West Glover and Westlook I: Nick will contact the abutting landowners for both West Glover and Westlook I.
14. Plans for Marking the Unmarked graves at French & West Glover: Nick will bring in the pegs that can be placed on each grave.
15. Rewilding Cemeteries: What does "re-wilding" mean? The Commissioners are considering having the burial area mowed/brushhogged more often than once a year. Why have corner markers on graves if they are not going to be seen? They would also like to see the access road mowed. How does Deb feel about the way the green/natural burial area looks?

18. Adjourn: The meeting was adjourned at 6:30pm




