Cemetery Commissioners Meeting Minutes Tuesday, June 28, 2023 – Municipal Building

Present: Joan Alexander, Theresa Perron-Janowski and Cindy Epinette.

Absent: Ricky Blanchard

1. The meeting was called to order at 5:10pm

2. Approval of Old Minutes: The minutes dated September 14, 2023 were approved.

- 3. **Financial Update:** Cindy indicated there was \$3,423.10 in the checking account, \$17,960.57 in the PC Savings account, \$1,705.71 in the Improvement account and \$66,587.62 in the CD. We've received \$6,220 between donations and lot sales and \$8444.20 in expenses to date. All looks good.
- 4. Memorial Garden Update: Kate Butler is quite busy with her business. She may be able to work on the Memorial Garden pathway by the end of July. Theresa will follow up with her. After the path is constructed, the border boulders can be placed and flowers and trees planted. Cindy will follow up with Heritage Memorial to decide if the boulder on Wayne Alexander's property, the other half of the boulder that was used for the Alexanders' head stone, is in good shape or if a plaque could be used.
- 5. Green/Natural Burial Update: Nick planted a tree. He may want to plant trees in the fall along with other plants. There has been no update from funeral homes regarding storage of a body during the winter months when the cemetery is closed. Heritage Memorial needs to map out the green/natural burial lots before a lot is sold.
- 6. Workbee Reports: Westlook I and West Glover Work Bees were a success. Eight people attended to learn and help on each date. The workers were appreciated and the weather was good. Ricky mentioned a limb fell into the West Glover Cemetery. Joan contacted Nick to see if he would be interested in assessing the situation. He came in and blocked up the wood. We need to go in to finish removing the branches.

7. Fence Plans:

- a. Paul Trucott, Caledonia Work Crew, is scheduled to construct the fence, at Westlook II, on August 23 26, 2023, with 5-6 inmates. We need to pay \$25/day and purchase the materials needed. A portalet needs to be placed in close proximity to the work site for the inmates. Paul will send a contract with a list of the materials needed.
- b. Painting Fence: Nila Maher and Waylon Young may be interested in painting the Westlook I fence.
- c. Andersonville Fence: Aiden Blanchard is scheduled to work on the front section of fencing at the end of July.
- d. Westlook I Fence: We have scheduled a work bee for September 23rd to work on this fence. Please bring rakes, post hole diggers, weed wacker, loppers, clean brush and recruit two helpers. We need to advertise for help.
- 8. Sign Plans: no plans
- 9. Other: Bonnie Moran would like to be buried in Section C of Westlook II, her remains will be cremated.
