


**TOWN OF GLOVER**  
**Cemetery Commissioners Meeting Minutes**  
**Wednesday, August 28, 2024 – French Cemetery**

Present: Joan Alexander, Theresa Perron, Amy Wright and Cindy Epinette, Cemetery Sexton.  
Absent: Deb Wesoja and Nick Ecker-Racz.


1. Theresa Perron called the meeting to order at 5:13pm.
2. **Minutes:** The minutes dated July 31, 2024 were approved.
3. **Financial update:** Cindy distributed the financial report. Everything is looking good. We have received a total of \$6,627 from donations as a result of the appeal letter.
4. **Cemetery Updates:**
  - a. **Westlook II: Green/Natural Burial Area:** The road crew are working on drainage from Glover Park in order to prevent erosion in the Green/Natural Burial section of the cemetery. The person that mowed the lower section of the cemetery and the town owned section did not do as much damage to the trees as initially believed. Many of the trees have survived. We would like Jeff Currier to brush hog the upper section of the cemetery before winter. Joan has been in touch with Paul Trucott regarding enlisting the help of the inmates to continue building the fence on the south side of the cemetery. Joan will order more boards for the job. She will order a few extra boards so the rotten boards in Westlook I and II can be replaced as needed. Waylon has completed his community service hours, as part of the Lake Region Union High School graduation requirements. He is now working for the Cemetery Commissioners. He will continue working on staining the fence.
  - b. **Memorial Garden:** A gentleman on Beach Hill has donated several plants. They are being stored at Theresa's for the time being. Theresa will email some proposed dates everyone can get together to plant them in the memorial garden. Theresa will contact a relative about a boulder that could be used to inscribe the name and dates of anyone whose ashes will be buried here.
  - c. **Traditional Update:** none
  - d. **Westlook I Update:** Clearing brush away from some stones is still on Cole's list of things to do.
  - e. **French Update:** There is one stone that has broken in two pieces again and in need of repair. A small tree has also fallen into the cemetery. There is no damage to any stones.
  - f. **Andersonville Update:** The work bee is scheduled for this Saturday, August 31<sup>st</sup> from 9-12pm. Joan has reviewed what needs to be done. There are no stones in need of epoxy work, only cleaning and resetting.
  - g. **West Glover:** Some trees need to be removed before they fall into the cemetery and break some stones. More information from Nick is needed.
5. **Brochure:** Amy needs a picture of Westlook II to add to the brochure. Theresa will review it and work with Amy to finalize it. It is agreed the brochure should be in color. Amy has done a wonderful job. Thank you!!
6. **Repair quote from Heritage:** no information has been received from Heritage.
7. **Signage Update:** Nick is working on this. No update.

8. **Fencing around sides and back of Westlook Update:** Nick was working on this. No update.
9. **Last regular summer work bee this Saturday 9am-Noon at Andersonville**
10. **Dowser Update:** Alice Herwood Chester will grave dowse French and West Glover Cemeteries on September 5th, beginning at 8:30am. There are several areas where we cannot determine if a body has been buried, possibly an unmarked grave, or the headstones have fallen or there is nothing there. We would like to confirm one way or the other.
11. **Other:** Joan proposed replacing the "Welcome" box at French Cemetery. The existing box has seen better days.
12. **Next meeting:** September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024, 5pm at the Town Clerk's Office.
13. **Adjourn: The meeting was adjourned at 6:10pm**




