

Glover Energy Committee Meeting 9/1/25

**MERP-**

Still awaiting mechanical and electrical drawings, mechanical should be week of 9/1 and electrical should be week of 9/8.

Municipal/Library- Windows- there are 26 windows that could be replaced. Have a spec for historically correct windows approx \$800 a piece, \$1500 installed. Will bid per piece so that if the budget doesn't allow for all to be replaced we can remove some. Space above the library there is a 3rd floor that is only used for storage, can we insulate below that space rather than above? Need to check with Town Clerk to verify that is acceptable.

Town Hall- Will put in the mechanical room to the left of the stage, confirmed with Theresa that it will provide sufficient storage as well. There will be two heating/cooling units one for upstairs and one for downstairs. Need to have the fuel vendor come to determine where the propane tank can go. Will probably have to go behind the building because the well is in the front. Electric service will need to be upgraded from 100 to 200 amps and need to replace the downstairs windows, will use the same spec window as for the municipal/library.

Fire Station-Gaskets around the bay doors will be replaced and all the people doors need to be replaced. ADA-need to put in a ramp and bathroom needs to be accessible. Current bathrooms are not considered accessible, discussed converting to one bathroom. Will follow up with the fire department about their thoughts and determine if it is an emergency shelter if there needs to be two. Also need to have the propane vendor determine where to put the propane tank. Electric service/generator needs to be reconfigured to bring it up to code.

Coe's did put out a prebid notice but need the rest of the drawings before the official bid can go out.

Window Dressers- A prior customer asked for more windows and another woman reached out. Kevin @ Craftsbury said if we have enough volunteers that is fine to go over our estimated 50 inserts. Mariel, Ann and David will be measuring this week.

VEEP- Will see how much funding we have left in the MERP mini grant and then contact the schools to see if there is interest.

Next meeting 9/15 Coe's anticipate having the drawings by then and will come with an update. We will have Allie @ NVDA participate in that meeting as well re- updating the town energy plan. NVDA has a dinner coming up in October at Highland Center for the Arts.
