September 12, 2022

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:08pm.
2. Minutes from last meeting – Ted Young made a motion, seconded by Heidi Ecker-Racz, to approve the minutes dated August 8, 2022. The motion carried. Adam made a motion, seconded by Michelle, to approve the minutes dated May 19, 2022. The motion carried.
3. Update on Skunk Hollow Grant and Greensboro Landowners: A grant was applied for for the Hinman Trail. There will be no trail access in Greensboro at this time. There is a dispute between the Freemans and Murdocks.
4. Black Hills Trails: Richard Carbonetti was present to discuss the trails system in the Black Hills. He stated the Black Hills trails are open to the public between January and August but closed between September and December due to the Hunt Club. There is 18 miles of trails in the Black Hills. ATV's, snowmobiles and bikes are prohibited from using the trails unless it's for maintenance purposes. There are two trails open year-round. Richard has requested GPS coordinates if an invasive species of plant is identified. He also requests notification when work on the trails is scheduled. There are two good access points to the trails, Hinman road and Runaway Pond.
5. Slide show of kiosks, trail building options for wetlands, handicap access, signage: Michelle presented a slide show of trail designs and kiosk designs in other locations in Vermont and Maine.
6. Glover Landowner Agreement: Peggy requested feedback regarding the Landowner Agreement.
7. ARPA Funds Application due end Sept. Recreations Trails Needs and Estimates: Peggy needs itemized expenditure needs for Glover Trails that can be included in the request for ARPA Funds by Monday, September 26th. For example: Richard Carbonetti's large Black Hills Map needs appropriate framing and protective covering.
8. Schedule Next Meeting: October 10, 2022 at 7pm at the Glover Town Hall.
9. Schedule Next Explore Glover Hike: Peak fall foliage trek in West Glover will be organized by Dominic and Noel. Details will be published on the website and Facebook.
10. Other Business: Peggy will arrange a trail maintenance work day with Richard Carbonetti and volunteers for the Hinman/Skunk Hollow section of the Glover Trails. Details will be published on the website and Facebook.
