
1. Meeting called to order at 6:30pm.
2. Introduction of those present.
3. Review of Agenda: The Board added a discussion regarding road update, VTrans meeting update, town office hours update and senior meals update.
4. Reading and Approval of March 26, 2020: David made a motion, seconded by Brian to approve the minutes as presented. The motion carried.
5. Appearances by Local Citizens and Visitors: none.
6. Announcements for Review: none.
7. Reports:
 - a. Glover Neighbors Project: Energy Committee members and other concerned residents are organizing to create a phone tree. Anyone who would like to be on the phone tree should respond on the town's website. Anyone who would like some assistance during this pandemic should also respond. This effort is not just to reach out to the vulnerable population. It's meant to keep everyone informed and provide assistance where needed.
 - b. Glover Recycling: The Recycling center remains closed until further notice. Lyndonville Recycling and Coventry Landfill are still open for those who would like to get rid of their recycling and garbage.
 - c. Road Update:
 - i. The road crew is keeping busy doing road work, such as grading. With the snow that is coming tonight Harvey will plow the paved roads, but the dirt roads are too soft to plow without causing the road to become worse;
 - ii. Sweeping: Harvey will research the possibility of renting a skid steer to remove the sand from the paved roads;
 - iii. The Board requested Harvey reduce the crown on Bean Hill road below the bridge;
 - iv. New Truck: The manufacturer has informed Harvey that there will be a delay on delivering the new truck, due to production being on hold;
 - v. Tree Removal: Nick has created a map with all the trees that need to be removed. Jack will follow-up with Nick to discuss the next step.
8. Old and Unfinished Business:
 - a. Town response to COVID-19: see Glover Neighbor Project.
 - b. VTrans Meeting: Jack will stay in touch with Eric Pope regarding scheduling a time to meet with VTrans.
 - c. Town Office Update: The town office is open for business but closed to the public.

 - a. Senior Meals: Randy Williams sent an email and notice on Front Porch Forum indicating Glover Senior Meals is looking for donations so they can continue to operate during this pandemic. Gloria estimates she needs \$500 in donations.

a. Review the bills and signing of orders:


11. Adjourn: Brian made a motion, seconded by David, to adjourn at 7:15pm.


