The food will be prepared by volunteers at home and served at the Barton Meal Site. We committed to provide a noon meal for 20-25 people on June 20, July 18 and August 15. We'll provide a main course, a side dish, salad, dessert and drink. We'll also be responsible for set up and clean up. The Center for an Agricultural Economy has a grant that they will purchase food with. Lindsey, Mariel, Darlene, Joan, Barb and Jethro will coordinate about the meal on June 20. Jethro will see about getting suggestions for menus.
