Sensory Trail

Jethro, Carolyn and Terra presented a slideshow of the current status of the sensory trail. The presentation will also be shared with the Glover Selectboard and the UVM intern cohort. The ten stations being built are: Sense of Motion, Sense of Rhythm and Sound; Sense of Wonder; Sense of Peace; Sense of Touch; Sense of Sight, Sense of Smell; Sense of Balance; and Sense of Rock 'n' Roll. Ten cedar benches have been constructed as well as several garden beds. The concrete piers are ready for the timber frame of the pavilion. The timbers for the structure are being cut for the 24'x 16' pavilion which will have one wall. A sign for the park on Route 122 is in the works. The timber raising event is planned for Friday, July 19 starting at 8 a.m. The crew will handle the raising but volunteers may be able to support their work. Jethro plans to solicit Parker Pie to provide a pizza lunch. The committee will provide cold drinks.
