


TOWN OF GLOVER
Selectboard Meeting Minutes
Thursday, September 22, 2022


Present: Dave Simmons, Phil Young, Cindy Epinette, Transcriber and Trisha Ingalls, the Chronicle.
Absent: Leanne Harple and Brian Carroll, Town Administrator.

1. The meeting was called to order at 6:30pm.
2. **Changes to the Agenda:** The Board received a Childhood Cancer Awareness letter and a notice from Springer Law Office.
3. **Approval of Minutes: Dave made a motion, seconded by Phil to approve the minutes dated September 8, 2022. The motion carried.**
4. **Road Update:** The Road crew has been resurfacing Mud Island and Dexter Mtn roads. They've also been working on ditches on Cold Spring and Daniels Pond roads. The areas on Shadow Lake road, where additional culvert work was completed, will be paved tomorrow, weather permitting.
5. **Town Health Officer Update:** Phil has been in contact with the VT Department of Health and the Sheriff's office regarding concerns about a piece of property in Glover. He will visit the premises in question, with a deputy, before the next meeting to gather more information. He will consult with VT Department of Health again if necessary.
6. **ARPA Update/Action:** The ARPA Committee has received several additional applications. They will make recommendations to the Selectboard at the next meeting.
7. **Orleans County Sheriff's Report (August):** The Board reviewed the August Sheriff's report. No action needed.
8. **Shadow Lake Sign Review:** At the last board meeting the Board agreed to purchase a sign for Shadow Lake Beach, indicating watercrafts should not be launched from the beach. They reviewed a draft of a sign that will be printed stating "Please Do not launch watercrafts of any types on the beach. This includes kayaks and paddleboards".
9. **Childhood Cancer Awareness Week:** The Board received an email requesting the Town of Glover recognize Childhood Cancer Awareness Week from October 23th – October 29th. The Board agreed to this request.
10. **Springer Law Office, PLLC:** The Board received a notice from Springer Law Office regarding a petition filed requesting a Certificate of Public Good for a de minimis modification to a wireless telecommunications facility on Dexter Mtn road.
11. **Open Public Comment: none.**
12. **The Directors Orders were signed.**
13. **Adjourn: Dave made a motion, seconded by Phil, to adjourn the meeting at 6:49pm.**


