Glover Trails Committee Minutes
Glover Town Hall, May 19, 2022, 7pm

1. Noel Ford called the meeting to order at 7pm.
2. Elections:
 - a. Chair: Noel Ford nominated Peggy Gibson, seconded by Heidi Ecker-Racz. The nomination was approved.
 - b. Vice Chair: no one was nominated.
 - c. Secretary/Treasurer: Randy nominated Cindy Epinette, seconded by Betsy Day. The nomination was approved.
 - d. Media/Electronic Coordinator: Noel Ford nominated Michelle Dominijanni, seconded by Betsy Day. The nomination was approved.
 - e. The group agreed to schedule meetings for the second Monday of each month, to begin at 7pm and held at the Glover Town Hall.
3. Michelle reviewed the survey results. Many people have responded to a survey regarding who is interested in opening their land to hikers, walkers, horses, etc and concerns they have about doing so. To view more information go to glovertrails.org.
4. Funding: Peggy will approach the Selectboard to use some of the funds in the GREC bank account to begin work on trails. Once the ARPA application form is created she will apply for those funds as well. There may be state funds available, however, the state requires a 5-10 year commitment from the landowner, in writing. You can go to "VT Parcel Viewer" to identify specific landowners. There is also a website, "All Trails", to view the trails in Vermont.
5. Hikes: Two hikes will be scheduled each month. The first one is scheduled for June 4th. Anyone who would like hike/walk the Black Hills should meet at 9am at Shadow Lake parking. Jim Currier will lead the hike. The next hike/walk is scheduled for June 18th on the Hinman/Skunk Hollow trail, with Peggy and Heidi Ecker-Racz leading. Anyone who would like to hike/walk should meet at Halsey Lane (on Hinman Road) at 9am.
6. Farmer's Market will begin on June 12th and Glover Day is scheduled for July 30th. It was suggested someone from the Trails Committee be present for each of these events.
7. Adjourn: Betsy made a motion, seconded by Randy, to adjourn the meeting at 9:05pm.
