

IMPORTANT STORM SAFETY TIPS

IF YOU'RE IN AN EMERGENCY

- Call 911

REPORT DAMAGE TO ROADS + HOME

- If you're not in an emergency but have experienced significant damage or are stranded in your shelter, call 211, and your town officials to report your situation

SHELTER IN PLACE

- If your shelter is safe, *stay off the roads*.
- Review and discuss your emergency plans, take inventory of your supplies and check your safe room

DON'T WAIT TO EVACUATE

- If you were flooded last year and/or you're concerned about your safety, please don't wait to evacuate

STAY INFORMED

- Keep in touch with your neighbors
