


# Town of Glover Selectboard Meeting Minutes


Thursday, July 23, 2020

Present: Jack Sumberg, David Simmons, Brian Carroll, David Snedeker, NVDA, Brad Gebbie, Brad & Cori Dudley, Christina Tooker, Shadow Lake Association, Dan Clark, Liz Nelson, Randy Williams, Glover Planning Commission, Cindy Epinette, Transcriber.

1. Meeting called to order at 6:31pm.
2. Review of Agenda: The Board added a discussion regarding internet service at the town hall and noise complaints in Glover village.
3. Minutes: **Dave made a motion, seconded by Brian, to approve the minutes dated July 9, 2020. The motion carried.**
4. Appearances by Local Citizens and Visitors:
  - a. David Snedeker – NVDA: The Glover Planning Commission is researching ways to enhance the town green to make it more appealing. There may be planning grant funding available through NVDA, VT Community Development, VT Council on Rural Development and VT Agency of Natural Resources.
  - b. Shadow Lake Association: Christina Tooker was present in Jen Andrews absence. Shadow Lake Association submitted a letter identifying several concerns pertaining to the roads and traffic near the Shadow Lake Beach. Jack addressed the following issues: Shadow Lake Road is the next road scheduled to be paved once the state will match funding, the state controls when the road will be lined/stripped with the center and side lines, mowing the sides of the road have begun, the tree warden can identify the trees that pose a safety issue for pedestrians and motorists. Other issues presented were a request to have Shadow Lake road patrolled more by the sheriff's department, lower the speed limit around the lake, and moving the ditch to allow for a walking path. Jack will consult with Harvey about any ditching and culvert work scheduled around Shadow Lake this summer.
5. Announcements for Review: none.
6. Reports:
  - a. Roads Report: none.
  - b. Orleans County Sheriff's Office Report (June): The Board reviewed the June report. The Board noted a significant increase in reportable incidences. No action taken.
7. Old and Unfinished Business:
  - a. Salt Shed – Bid Opening: Only one bid was received, Peter's General Contracting at \$98,112.00. No action taken.
8. New Business:
  - a. Wastewater Security Vulnerability Self-Assessment: This is a required self-assessment as part of the wastewater loan with USDA. Jack will complete it and seek assistance from VT Rural Water Association as needed.
  - b. Political signs on town property: Jack was approached for permission to post political signs on town owned property. He declined the request. The Board supported his response to this request.
  - c. 2020 Tax Rate: **Brian made a motion, seconded by Dave, to approve the 2020 tax rates of \$1.9924 for homestead and \$2.2797 for non-residents. The motion carried.**

- d. Town Hall Internet Service: Jack requested a quote to install internet service at the town hall so board meetings can be held there. Jessica received a quote of \$70/month. The Board supports this proposal. Jack will research further
  - e. Noise complaints in the village: Brian will speak with the sheriff's department about these complaints. The Board would prefer community members respecting the rights of their neighbors so a need for a noise ordinance is not required.
9. Board Action:
- a. The Board signed the director's orders.
10. Adjourn: Dave made a motion, seconded by Brian, to adjourn at 8:41pm.
