

# Glover Selectboard Meeting

## Minutes

Thursday, March 25, 2021

Present: David Simmons, Brian Carroll, Leanne Harple, Dan Clark, Randy Williams and Cindy Epinette, Transcriber. Attending via Zoom: None.

1. The meeting called to order at 6:30pm.
2. Introduction of those present.
3. Review Agenda: The Board added a discussion about opening the Town Hall for yoga, an update on purchasing a laptop, an update on the planning grant and designating a custodian of records.
4. Approval of March 11, 2021 and March 19, 2021 minutes: **Brian made a motion, seconded by Leanne, to approve the minutes as posted. The motion carried.**
5. Appearances by Local Citizens and Visitors:
  - a. Randy Williams
    - i. Planning Grant: The Planning Commission interviewed several candidates to be consultants. They chose Dubois & King. Dubois & King will send a contract for the Board to review/sign. The Planning Commission has been awarded a planning grant from the State for \$24,000 and the town will have to match with \$2,400. They anticipate the planning process will be completed by the end of December 2021. Dave and Brian will speak with Eric Pope at VTrans regarding the maintenance of Glover Street between Still Hill and Red Sky Trading. They envision re-establishing the sidewalk between the village and Kate Butler's, installing crosswalks, hanging banners and building planters. More meetings will be scheduled to include the Selectboard and the public. The Planning Commission will review the Town Plan to determine if money, the town expects to receive, from COVID-19 relief can be used.
    - ii. Glover Day: Randy is optimistic that Glover Day will occur this year. The Glover Day committee is in the process of planning for this event.
    - iii. Farmers Market: June 13<sup>th</sup> is the first day the Farmers Market is scheduled to open.
    - iv. Pioneer Camp: Pioneer Camp is scheduled for the last week in June.
  - b. Announcements for Review: none.
6. Reports:
  - a. Road Update: Tree trimming on Shadow Lake road has happened. Dave will schedule, with Harvey, when he can attend meetings.
7. Old Business: none.
8. New Business:
  - a. Easter Sunday Services at Town Green: This request was withdrawn.
  - b. Yoga at the Town Hall: Tina Ghantous submitted a request to open the Town Hall for Yoga classes again. She assured the Board safety measures will be implemented, based on the State's guidelines, to ensure the safety of participants against spreading the coronavirus. **Brian made a motion, seconded by Leanne, to approve the request. The motion carried.**
  - c. Custodian of Records: Brian will speak with Jessica Sweeney about being appointed as the Custodian of Records.
  - d. Laptop Update: Brian has been researching the cost of replacing the Selectboard's laptop. Brian will review the restrictions of using any COVID-19

relief funds to finance this purchase. **Dave made a motion, seconded by Leanne, to purchase a laptop for no more than \$1,500.00. The motion carried.**


9. Board Action:


10. Adjourn: Brian made a motion, seconded by Leanne, to adjourn at 7:47pm.




