Glover Selectboard Meeting Minutes Thursday, March 26, 2015

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 6:35pm.
- 2. Agenda Amendments: The Board added a discussion about LEOP, School St and Flood Hazard Area Regulations.
- 3. Public Comment:
 - a. West Glover Parking: There was an incident at Parker Pie where a vehicle was towed by a neighbor. Ben discussed the incident and indicated the steps being taken to address this problem. Parker Pie has been proactive in preventing parking problems and will continue.
- 4. Board Discussion:
 - a. KNS Tire Recycling Green Up Day: The Board received a flyer to accepting tires collected on green up day. Jack will review.
 - b. Back to Work: The Board received a letter from the doctor's office, indicating Jim Pohlman received clearance to return to work on April 6, 2015.
 - c. Law Enforcement: Jack talked with the Orleans County Sheriff and Mike spoke with the State Police. Mike will call the State Police and invite them to a board meeting to discuss what services they will/can provide with or without a contract. The Selectboard encourages community members to share any issues (good and bad) they are having, or have had, regarding law enforcement so the Board may address these issues with the agencies providing law enforcement.
 - d. Ordinances: Jack will research enforcement of civil ordinances in the Town of Glover.
 - e. Local Emergency Operation Plan (LEOP): Mike will update the information in the plan.
 - f. Daniel's Pond Accident: There was an accident involving the plow truck on Daniel's Pond Rd. The insurance company has denied paying damages because there was no negligence on the part of the employee. Jack will follow up with the insurance company regarding denying paying for damages.
 - g. School Street/Driveway: There was a question as to whether School St is a street or a driveway. Jack will review information sent to the State to identify when/if it was designated as a street.
 - h. Flood Hazard Area Regulation: Mike will seek assistance with understanding and implementing this updated regulation, if the Town decides to adopt it.
- 5. Board Action:
 - a. Minutes: Mike made a motion, seconded by Jack, to approve the March 12, 2015 minutes as presented. The motion carried.
 - b. Director's Orders were signed.
