We discussed the possibility of creating a riverside park next to the town green. It is still unclear who owns the land, but the fire department seems to be the last owner. Craftsbury just had an open house for their new park. We should get the GREC group involved in the project.

Energy Committee: no new news from NVDA or the state on their requirements for town energy plans.

Randy spoke with the Barton Chamber and Jethro Hayman about our community calendar idea. Jethro thinks it is a great idea and suggested that we use Google Calendar rather than going to the Hardwick software company. Randy will pursue this idea.

Jim Bowes reported that he had gone through most of the appendix and made sure that all the references were correct. We did switch D and E sections.

Ann Lindner asked about the status of the bulletin boards that the Barton Chamber wants to give away. The Lake Parker Association is interested in having one installed somewhere in West Glover. We need to look seriously at where to put one in Glover Village. Currier's does not seem to be a good place, but the town green could be. We just need to make sure that it is easily seen and accessible to passersby.

Randy asked everyone to read through the entire plan and make sure that it reads well and nothing is left out or is incorrect in preparation for our final version, except of course for the Energy section.
