

Memphremagog Watershed Association and Greenleaf Design would like community input regarding plans they have developed for the Municipal Building, Glover Volunteer Fire Building and Glover Community School.

This presentation includes design concepts for different areas of the properties to address stormwater runoff and erosion issues. The locations and practices were selected to maximize erosion reduction and protection of water quality, work with existing infrastructure, and provide aesthetic and educational benefits to the community. The concepts are based on our site visits, site analysis, and conversations with some of you on your values, goals, and maintenance capacities. We did not include rough project costs and maintenance levels because the concepts are fairly similar in this regard and will be adapted to meet cost and maintenance goals in the final design phase, but please share questions or concerns relating to cost or maintenance if you have them. We want these practices to work for you and the Glover community, so we would love your input at this time! Feel free to share this with interested stakeholders.
