Solar Array: No update

Energy Efficiency for Town Buildings- State of VT has a new program starting SEMP(State Energy Management Plan) that has funding to help municipalities reduce energy use and curb greenhouse gas emissions. The priority building to start with we think would be the Town Hall, the Fire Dept and Ambulance building should be looked at as well. The Town Clerk office had some updates a couple of years ago so probably wouldn't be cost effective and the garage is new and efficient. Angela to follow up with Matt Kittredge new OCSU Facilities Director about the school facility and whether or not there is an emergency generator, if it is ever tested. Jack believes there is a generator that needs to be run by a tractor. If there is not a generator that might be good for ARPA funds or the SEMP program.
