

Glover Planning Commission meeting

November 28, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Randy at 6:30 PM. Jack, Ann C., Mariel, Jim, Joan Alexander, Jack and Liz were present.

Randy gave an overview of the revised town plan to Joan—why we have to do it, the research into it, subcommittees for different sections and how often we met.

Now the proposed plan has been sent to all the surrounding town by registered mail, NVDA and the Department of Housing and Community Development. We have received good feedback from interested citizens of Glover.

This is the public hearing to allow comment and ideas to be discussed. One of the most significant outcomes of this writing of the plan has been the Energy Committee which is now an ongoing group. They have become involved in existing programs like “Button Up” and conservation and energy education. We have not gotten involved in Act 46.

Joan wanted to know the path of this plan: now it goes to the Selectboard after we approve it tonight. If there is no conflict, the Selectboard has an open hearing and will vote to adopt it if there are no major objections requiring more discussion. Then it goes on to NVDA to be finally approved.

Ann C. thanked Randy and Mariel for all the work they have done; correlating and revising and organizing all the parts into a coherent piece preparing the Plan for review.

Ann C. moved to add the names of the Planning Commission to the plan as authors. Jim seconded and it was so voted.

Randy would like us to continue to meet to follow up on some of the ideas in the plan. Perhaps a citizens committee to create and maintain a central calendar. VT 211 is a resource of resources.

Maybe the Barton Chamber of Commerce could take on a calendar for the area.

Joan commented that the plan is interesting and even fun to read! Randy hasn't heard from any of the surrounding communities.

Mariel moved to adopt the plan and Ann C. seconded the motion. So voted. Jack has two copies for the Selectboard.

Randy thanks us all.

Jim moves to adjourn at 7:20 pm. So voted.
