Sub-committee meeting of the Glover Planning Commission September 17, 2020

The meeting began at 4:00 pm in the Glover Town hall. We had arranged to have a zoom conference with Alison Low of NVDA to discuss our application for a planning grant for the Town of Glover. Randy Williams, Stephen Low, Nick Ecker-Ratz, Meg Gibson, Tyler Buswell and Liz Nelson attended.

After moving to the stage to help with acoustics, we were joined by Alison with a Zoom call. We discussed the mechanics of applying for the grant – how to use the Municipal Planning Grant guide provided by the state. We will use Google docs to coordinate our proposal.

We also discussed the possibilities of the yellow house on the edge of the green, currently for sale. Alison said that in Hardwick, some businessmen bought the big yellow barn (the former Greensboro Garage) and formed a LLC to hold it while plans were made and grants were found to make it a welcome center and incubator for the town. We also discussed other possible projects associated with the town green, a removable ice skating rink, resolving the ownership of the green property, building a permanent structure like a gazebo or pavilion, expanding parking and also, getting access to the state owned land across Still Hill from the green.

We discussed the methods of applying for GEARS. Steve is going to contact Jessica Sweeney about connecting to GEARS. This must be done by the Town Clerk.
