Minutes

Thursday, September 24, 2020

Meeting called to order at 6:30pm.

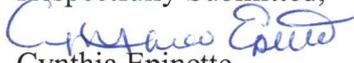
1. Review of Agenda: The Board added a discussion regarding the Planning Commission applying for a grant, sewer vulnerability assessment update, and the VLCT Safety Compliance Report
2. Minutes: **Brian made a motion, seconded by Dave, to approve the minutes dated September 10, 2020. The motion carried.**
3. Appearances by Local Citizens and Visitors:
 - a. Planning Commission – Randy Williams: The Planning Commissioners would like to apply for a planning grant through the Department of Housing and Community Development. The maximum amount granted is \$22,000 and the town share would be 10% of the grant total. The grant will be used to pay for consulting services, focusing on improvements to the town green and Glover village. Total grant amount will depend on the accepted planning proposal. **Dave made a motion, seconded by Brian, to approve signing the Resolution, designating Brian Carroll as the grant CEO, Dave Simmons as the Alternate CEO, and Brian as the Grant Administrator. The motion carried. Jack made a motion, seconded by Brian to appoint Steve Lowe to the Planning Commission. The motion carried.**
4. Announcements for Review:
 - a. Update on Municipal Grant for land record digitization: The grant has been awarded to the town. The Board will review the contract at the next meeting.
5. Reports:
 - a. Road Update:

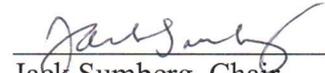
Shadow Lake Road – Several citizens attended the meeting to voice their objection to having the pavement on Shadow Lake road removed. They would like to see the road paved sooner than later. One resident voiced his support of removing the pavement and expressed his disappointment that pavement along the lake shore was not removed. Jack reviewed the decision behind removing the pavement on two sections of Shadow Lake road. State aid to pave the road is next anticipated in 2023. Culvert/ditching work need to be done in the meantime. The Board also indicated that the town can more effectively maintain gravel roads and asked the residents patience with the trial. The Board encouraged the residents to join them at the Annual Town Meeting in March.
 - b. Orleans County Sheriff's Office (August): The August report from Orleans County Sheriff's office was reviewed. Brian has not received any information about the previous questions. A report can be provided that indicates what road each violation occurred on. No action taken.
 - c. Sewer Vulnerability Assessment Update: Jack completed the Sewer Vulnerability Assessment and will send the Record of Completion form.
6. Old and Unfinished Business:
 - a. Social Media Policy Update: The Board discussed the proposed policy and made several changes. The policy will be updated and brought to the Board for adoption at the next meeting.
 - b. Speed Ordinance Update: The Board continued to discuss the speed limits on Glover roads. Several citizens expressed their opinion about reducing or leaving

the speed limits as is. Each board member will send their proposed speed limit changes, for each road, to Jack. Jack will summarize the proposed changes and they will be discussed at the next meeting.

- c. VLCT PACIF Safety Compliance Report: The Board reviewed the town insurer's concerns regarding safety issues at town buildings. All the concerns were considered low risk by VLCT.
7. New Business:
- a. Social Work Guides on Website: A private organization requested their website link be included on the town's website. The request was denied.
8. Board Action:
- a. The Board signed the director's orders.
9. Adjourn: Dave made a motion, seconded by Brian, to adjourn at 8:45pm.
